School Performance, Attendance and Homework Completion agreement

Dear Students and Parents,

- ◆ Parents please discuss the following issue of regular school attendance with your son or daughter thoroughly prior to applying to study in Australia. Your son or daughter are here to experience a cultural and educational experience while they are in Australia. This means they must attend school everyday, participate in all classes, have regular input during the lesson and complete all set homework and assignments while in Australia and not disrupt the free flow of the Australian schooling system and other Australian students.
- ◆ Please also read and discuss "The Campus Education Australia Student Handbook for Australia" thoroughly together, it will answer all your questions and queries.
- ◆ Please be aware that you (the student) are here to study, it is not a holiday as some think, you are here to enjoy both. If you feel this is one big holiday, then think carefully before joining the CEA program.
- ◆ All students will have reports made by the school in the first 4 weeks to see how they are progressing and fulfilling the agreement. Then a progress and school report will be made of each student regularly.
- ◆ If for any reasons, the school and CEA feel that that your son/daughter is not attending 100%, participating or completing set work or homework, then we will speak to them and find out why. A letter will be sent to your parents advising that you (the student) are not following the agreement contract signed by both yourself and parents prior to commencing the program.
- ◆ A first warning will be given and a letter to your parents. Continual checks will be made with the school and the host family by CEA to ensure your attitude has improved.
- ◆ If this is unsatisfactory, a second and last warning will be given to you and your parents will also be informed.
- ◆ If a third warning is necessary, then the Contract/Agreement has been broken. You have not fulfilled the obligations of the CEA exchange and your visa requirements have not been met. CEA will have no alternative but to automatically send back you home. This will be at the expense of your natural parents and contract will be voided. Any loss or legal expensed incurred by the student will be paid by their natural parents or legal guardian and there will be no refund of the program if this action has to be taken.
- ◆ School Reports/Assessment will be Transcribed - to ensure that your efforts and hard work have been acknowledged by your school in your country, your Australian report is to be taken to your consulate here in Australia to ensure is authenticity and this will be stamped. You will then take the report back with you on your return and have it transcribed and give to your present school on your return home to acknowledge the time spent here in an Australian school.
- ◆ We the parents and my son or daughter have read the above agreement and read the CEA Student Handbook thoroughly together and feel happy that we will follow the guidelines set by CEA and the school. (If at this stage you feel you can not follow the above, then we feel the program will not be suitable for you)
